



**Roadway Committee Meeting**

**Rindge Town Office**

**Date: June 12, 2024**

**MEETING MINUTES**

**Present:** Rindge Residents Philip Stenersen and Craig Clark, Planning Director Al Bump, Fire Chief Rick Donovan, Highway Director Mike Cloutier, Executive Secretary Victoria Stenersen, and member of the public Kale Stenersen. Absent from the meeting were Town Administrator Lori Rautiola and Police Chief Rachel Malynowski.

The meeting opened at 2:15 pm. Mike was appointed interim chair of the committee via a motion by Craig, seconded by Al, and passed 4-0.

**New Business:**

Cliff Harbor Project: There was a brief discussion regarding the project and Mike plans to contact Rob Faulkner after receiving the final go-ahead for the road.

Amalia Way: A letter was received by the roadway committee from Kale Stenersen requesting Amalia Way to become a Class V Road. Al asked about the road from the common land into the roadway and Kale responded that it is just a matter of a form being filled out and he has started the process. Al asked about the continuation certificate for the Road Completion Bond from January and Phil responded that it was not renewed as the road is complete. Al motioned to make a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen to place on a warrant article for the 2025 Town Meeting with the condition of the approval of Cliff Harbor. The motion was seconded by Craig and was passed by a roll call vote, Al aye, Craig aye, Rick aye, and Mike aye. Phil recused himself due to partiality.

Bean Hill Road: There was an application for the maintenance and improvement of a class VI road for Bean Hill Road from Michael Walega. There are no wetlands and about 100 yards are affected. The applicant will add gravel to improve the accessibility of the road and there will be no expenditure on the town. Phil motioned to make a recommendation to the Board of Selectmen to approve the application. Al seconded the motion, and the motion passed 5-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:32 pm via a motion by Craig, seconded by Phil, and passed unanimously.
